The following is an overview of the Department of Psychology requirements for a second Bachelor's degree in Psychology. Courses from previous institutions *may* count as equivalent courses of degree requirements. The Psychology Department Chair must make such determinations. A minimum of 30 credit hours beyond the first degree is required for a second Bachelor's degree. Students seeking a second degree are exempted from meeting University lower division core requirements but must take core courses required for the major.
